The Church was founded in 1848 as the first Catholic Church in Morristown. The Church Building (1872) and Rectory (1890) were constructed in the High Victorian Gothic style and the Ministry Center (c. 1870) was constructed in the Stick style. Church complex contributes to the New Jersey and National Register Historic District.

The 2013 grant helped complete a Preservation Plan for the exterior envelopes of the Church Building, Rectory and Ministry Center.

The 2014 grant provided for the replacement of gutters at side aisle of Church Building and at the front of the Ministry Center.

The 2015 and 2016 grants are assisting with roof restoration at the Rectory.
