## Phoenix House

2003 \$100,000 Exterior Painting

2014 \$15,808 Preservation Plan Update

**Grant Recipient:** Mendham Borough

**Location:** Mendham Boro.

The Phoenix House was built in the early nineteenth century, purchased in 1820 by William Phoenix for use as an inn, and then used from 1857 to 1907 by his daughters as a boarding house. The building is a fine example of the Federal style, with Greek Revival-style porches added in 1840. Since 1938, the building has been used as the Mendham Borough municipal offices and meeting spaces.

The 2003 grant provided for the removal of exterior paint on brick and wood surfaces and repainting.

The 2014 grant will complete an update to the 2001 Preservation Plan, including code and accessibility review, structural evaluation, window evaluation, and energy conservation evaluation.
