Waterloo Village

2012 \$22,257 District Expansion

Grant Recipient: Canal Society of New Jersey

Location: Mount Olive Twp.

Waterloo Village, located in Allamuchy Mt. State Park in Sussex and Morris Counties, is one of the best preserved Morris Canal sites in New Jersey. The Village is a key site for interpreting the relationship between industry, commerce, transportation and agriculture in mid-19th century New Jersey.

The 2012 grant will help provide for research and documentation to form the basis for updating the National Register nomination of Waterloo Village including the expansion of its current boundaries to include properties on the Morris County side of the river. The field documentation will inform a written summary which will include approximately 25 architectural and archaeological resources and their related elements.
