The Glenburn House, also known as the Van Ness House, was purchased in 2005 with assistance from the Morris County Open Space Trust Fund. The house is listed on the New Jersey and National Registers of Historic Places for local architectural significance. The c. 1860's house exemplifies the early homes that were remodeled in the Colonial Revival style in the 1920s or '30s as a form of appreciation of American colonial architecture. Picturesquely sited overlooking the Pequannock River, the Van Ness property includes the singular remaining house of its type in Riverdale.

The 2006 grant assisted with the completion of a Preservation Plan for the house, outbuildings and site.

The 2007, 2008 and 2009 grants provided for the stabilization and exterior restoration of the barn and house, as well as the stabilization of the house interior with the installation of heat, water and electricity.

The 2010 and 2011 Construction Grants at the house included door & window repair, the installation and repairs to the kitchen; installation of an accessible toilet room; an accessible entrance to the house; repair of the roof, chimney and masonry; emergency lighting, fire detection. Accessible toilet room in the Barn, stabilization of the Store Building. A separate Non-Construction grant is assisting with completion of a landscape study.

The 2012 Construction Grant will assist with Phase 3 Rehabilitation, including repair of the north porch and south terrace, and interior lighting. The 2013 Construction grant will rehabilitate the Store exterior, provide HVAC at the first and second floors of the House.

The 2014 grant is to complete interior structural repairs for the Store.
