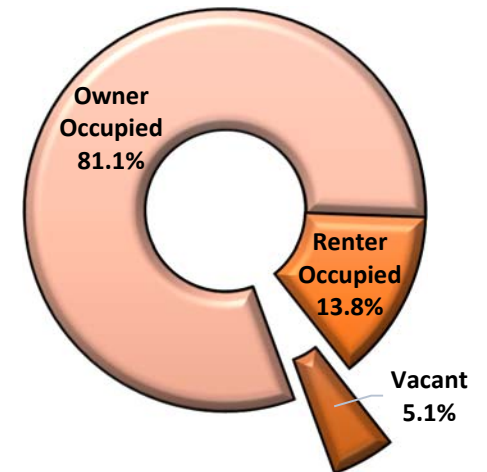
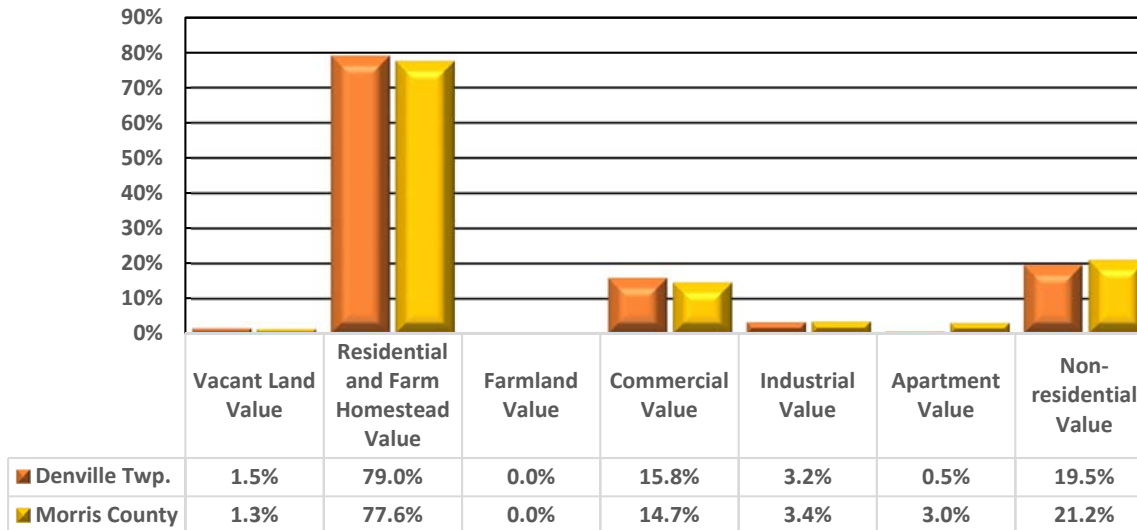

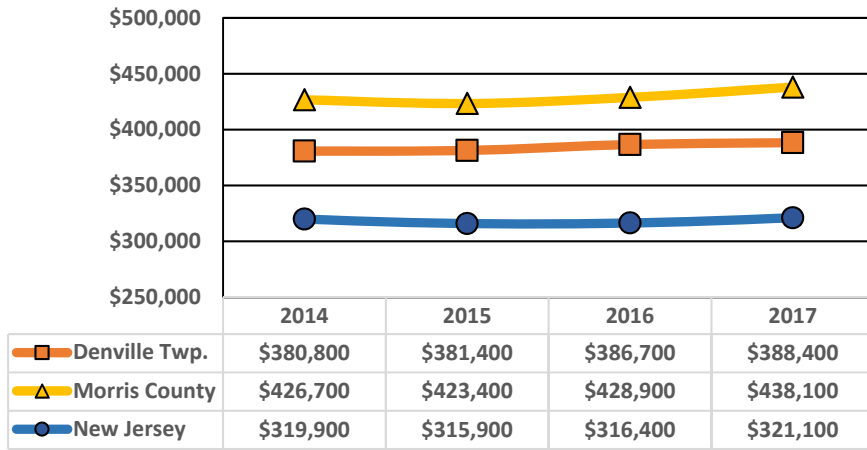
Parcel Values as a Percentage of Total Value

Housing Occupancy

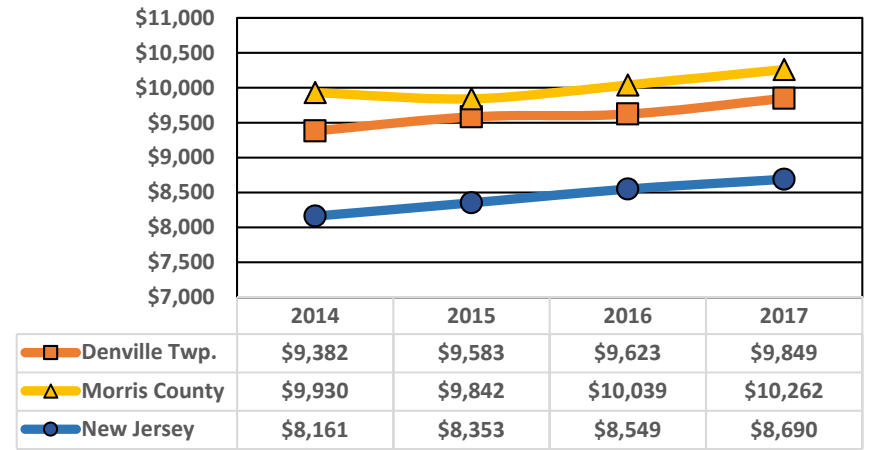

Median Housing Prices



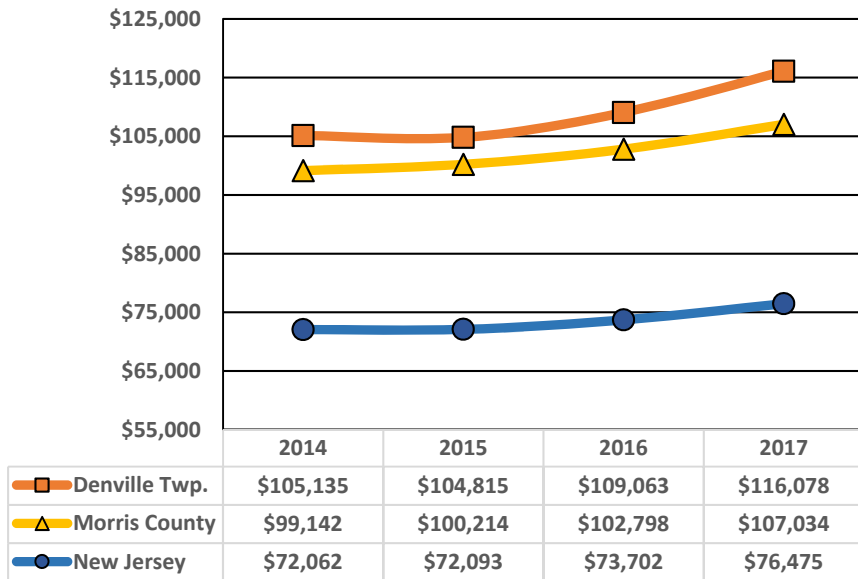
Average Residential Property Tax



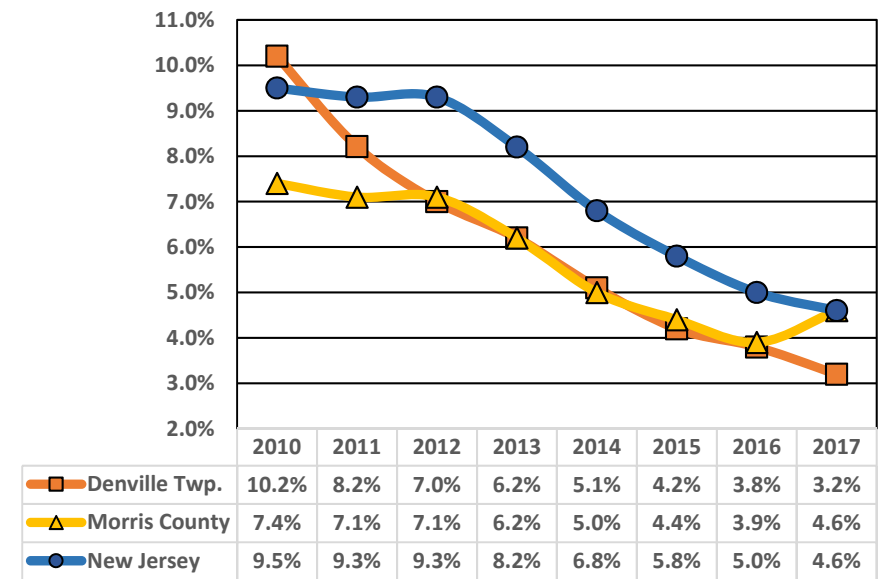

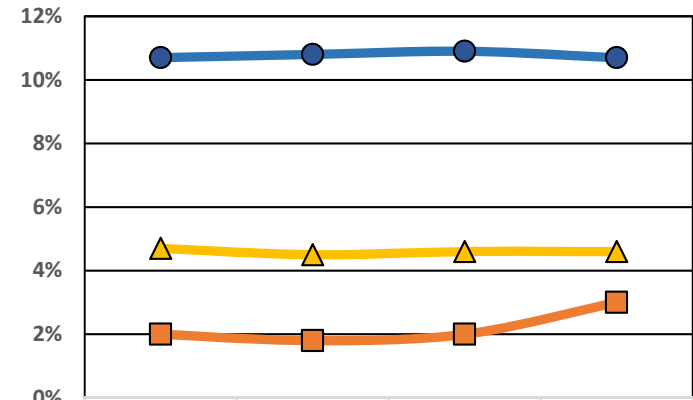
Unemployment Rate

Percent Below Poverty Level



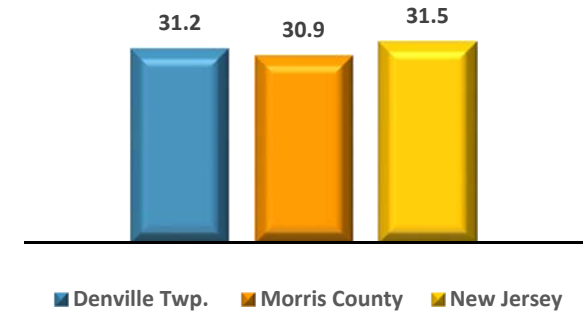
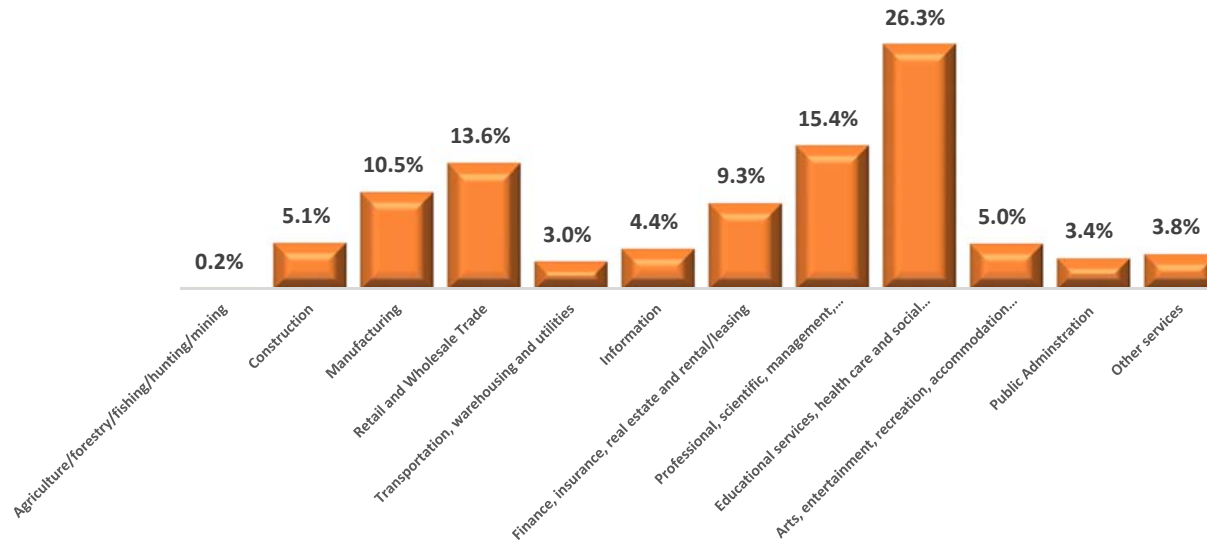

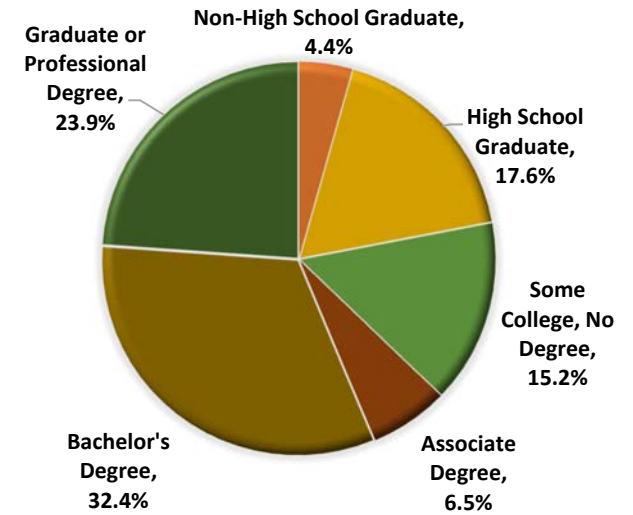
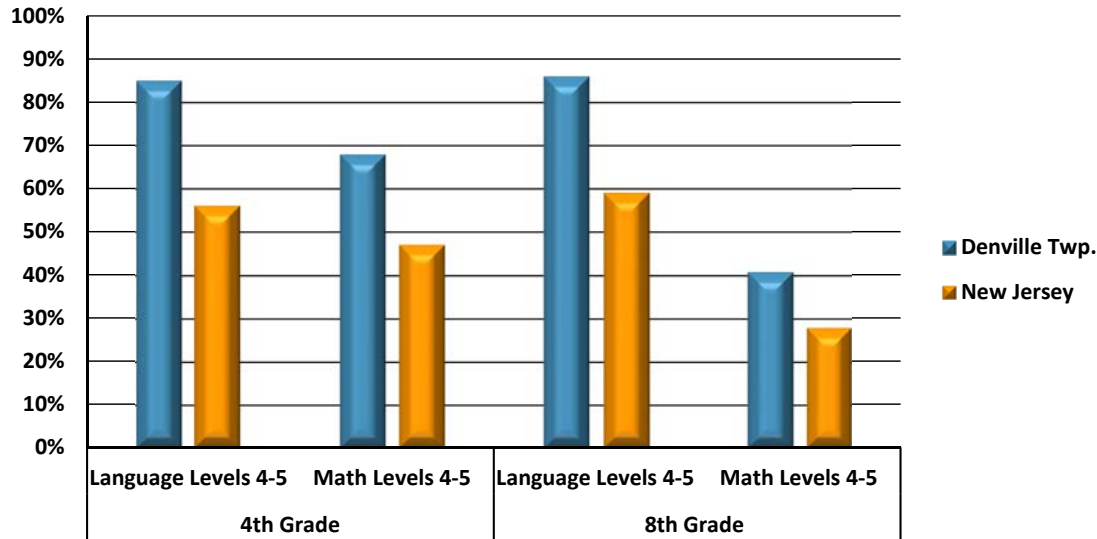

Highest Level of Education Attainment (=>25 years)



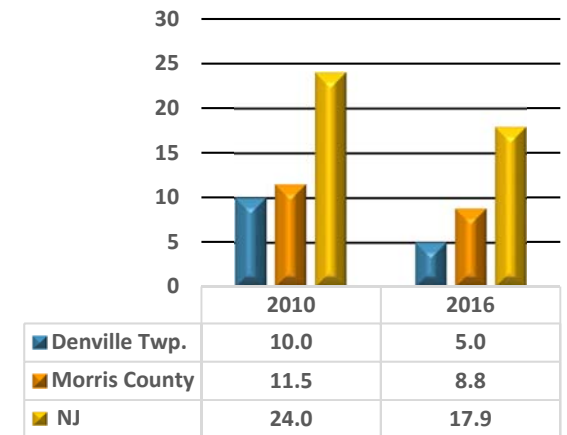
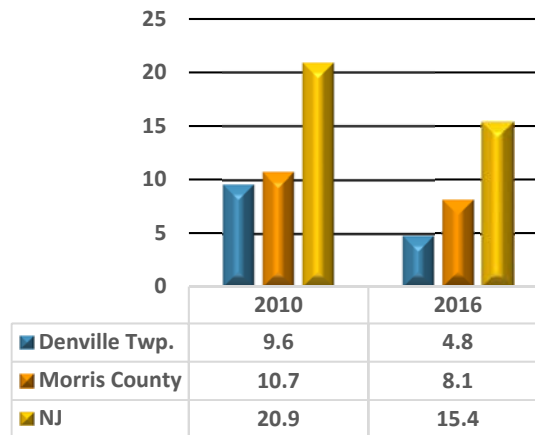
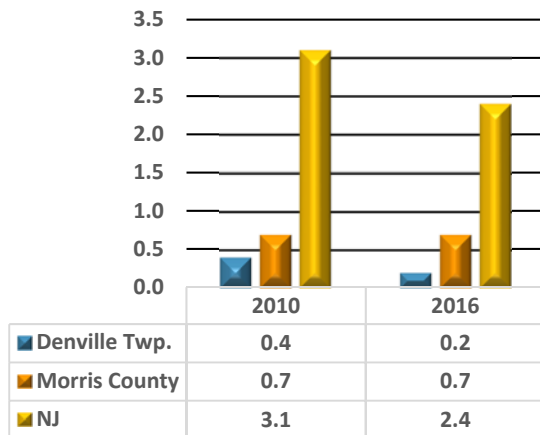
