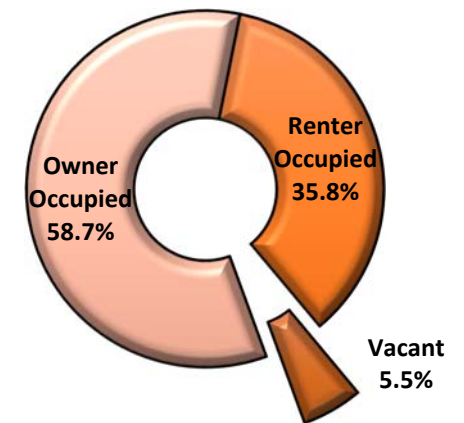
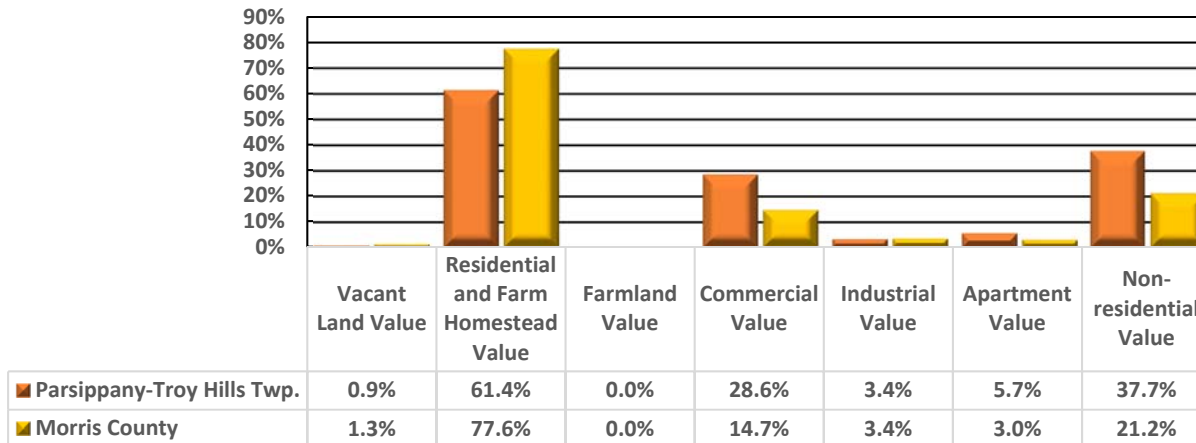

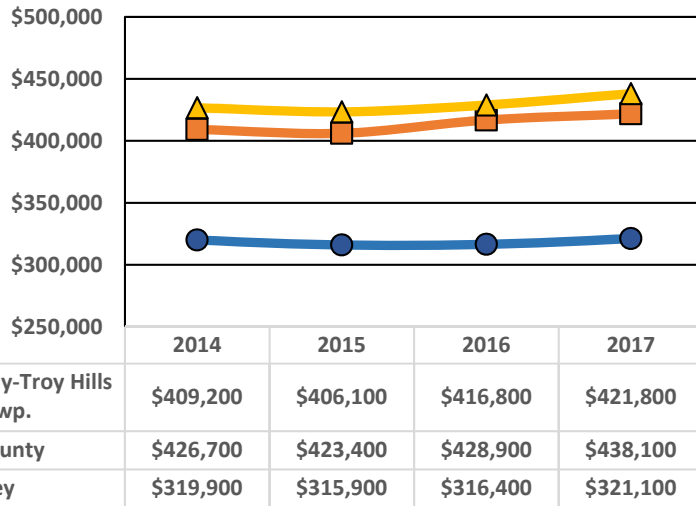
Parcel Values as a Percentage of Total Value

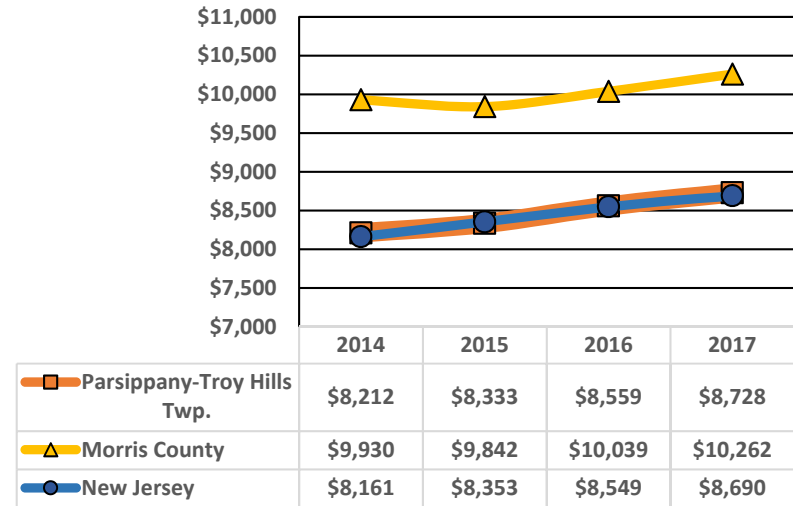

Median Housing Prices



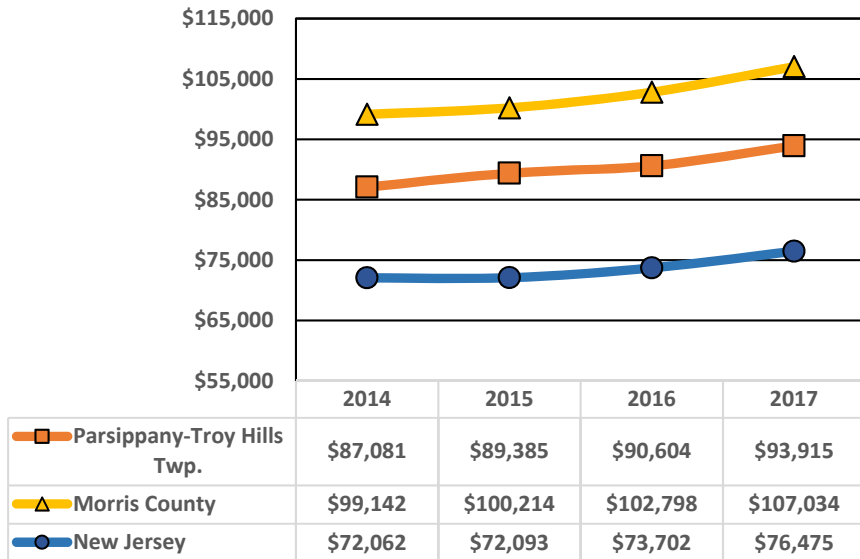
Average Residential Property Tax



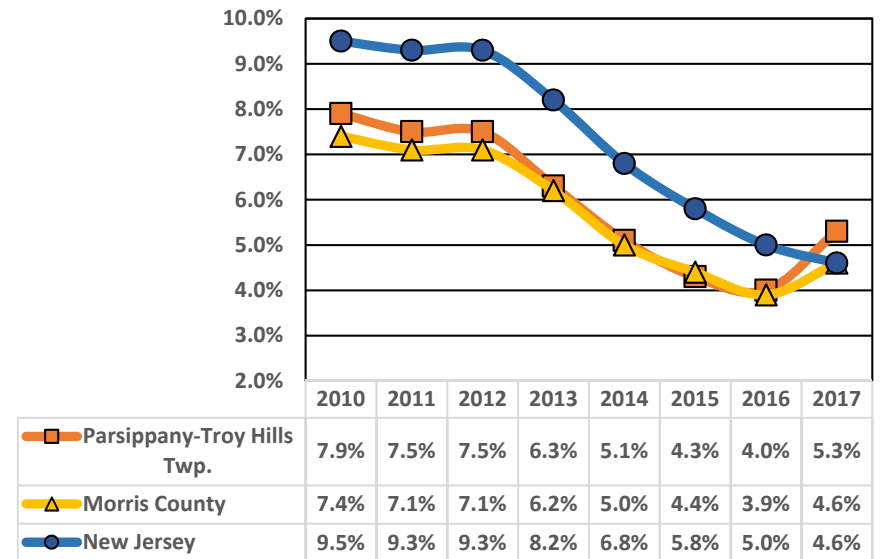

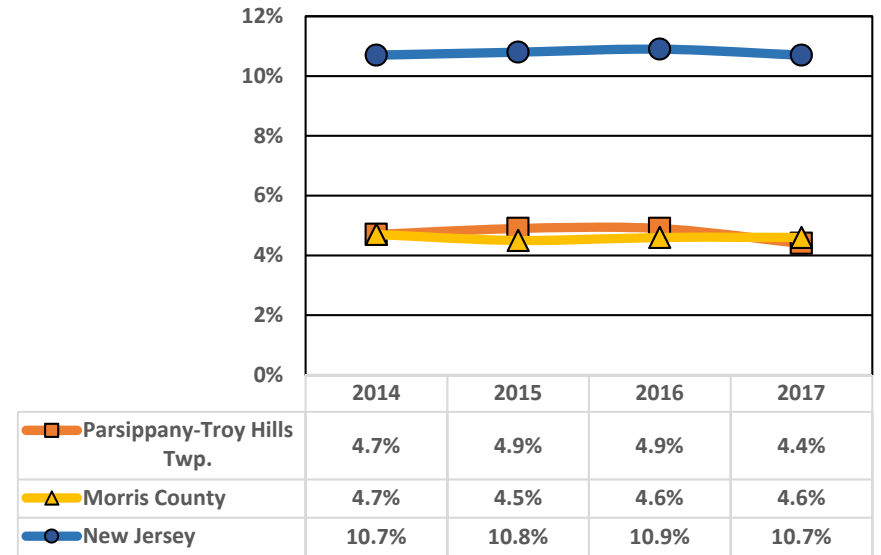
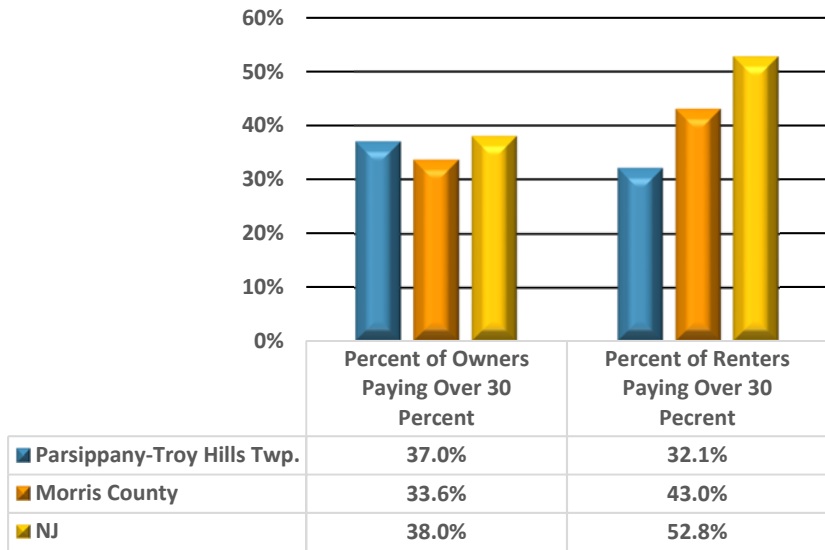
Unemployment Rate

Percent of Residents Paying More Than 30 Percent of Income on Housing

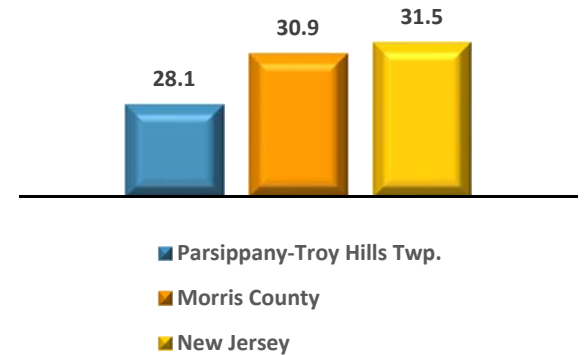
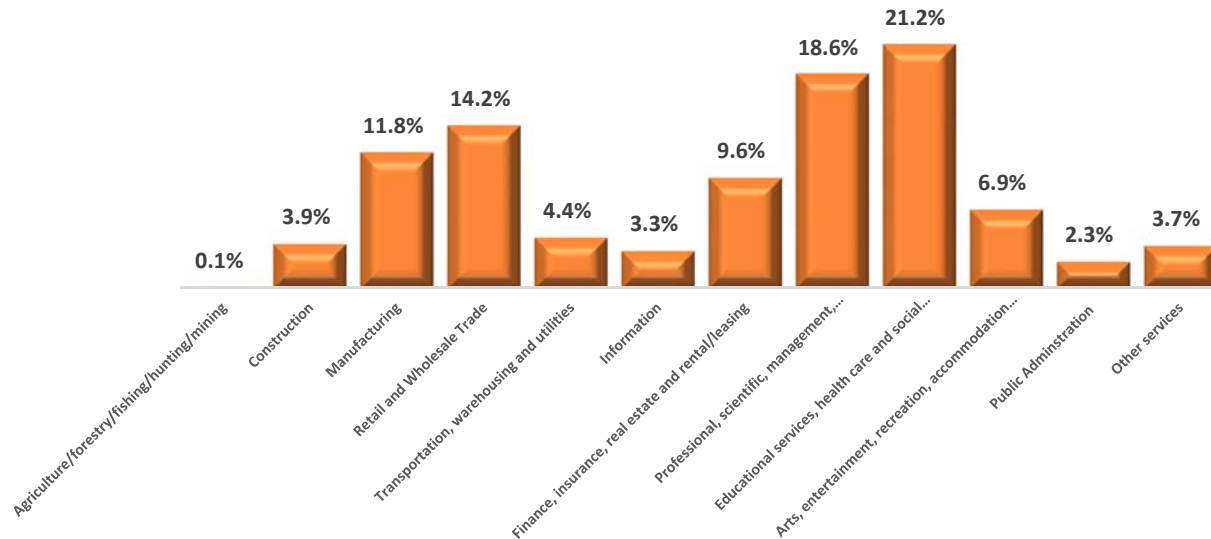
Percent Below Poverty Level

Mean Travel Time to Work (minutes)

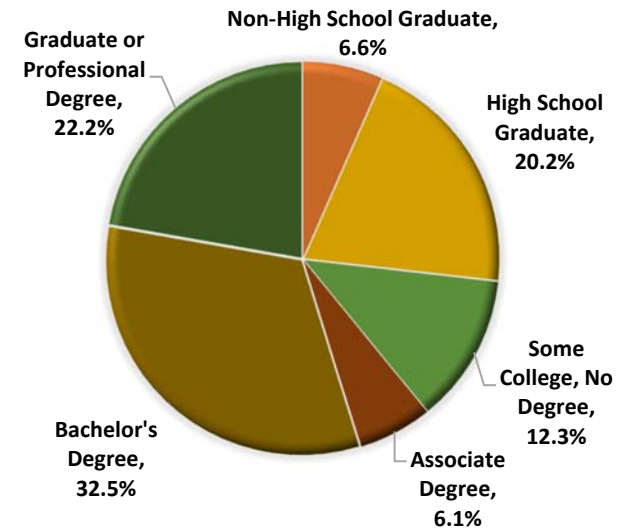
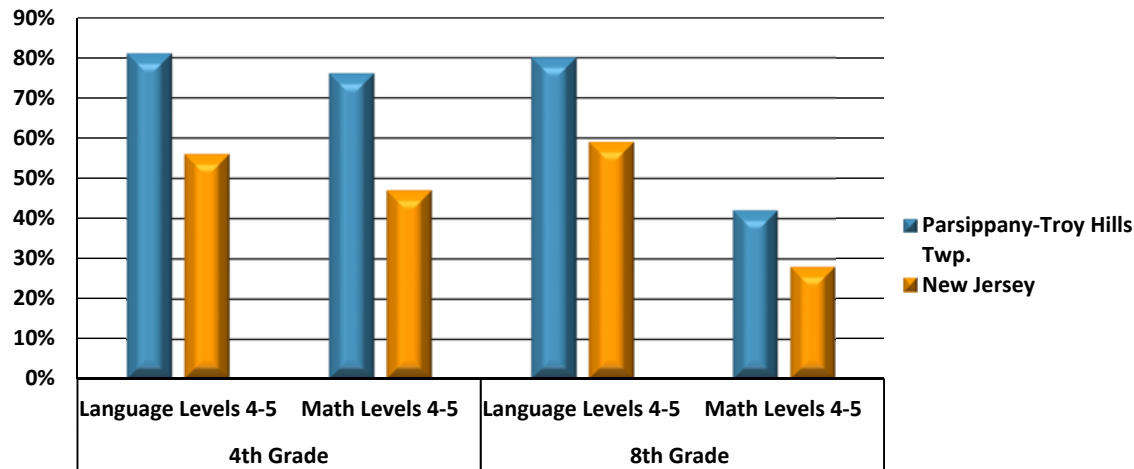

Highest Level of Education Attainment (=>25 years)



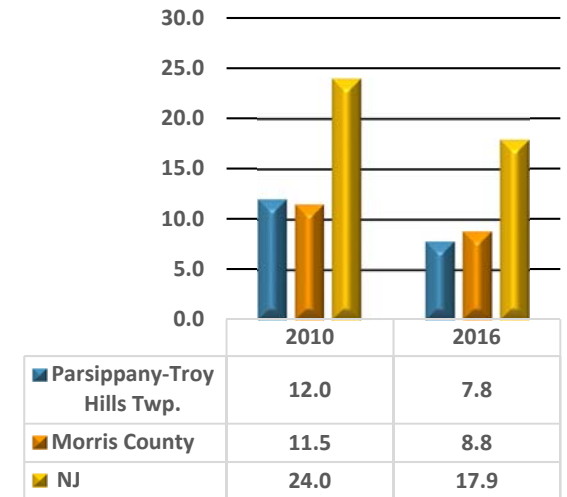
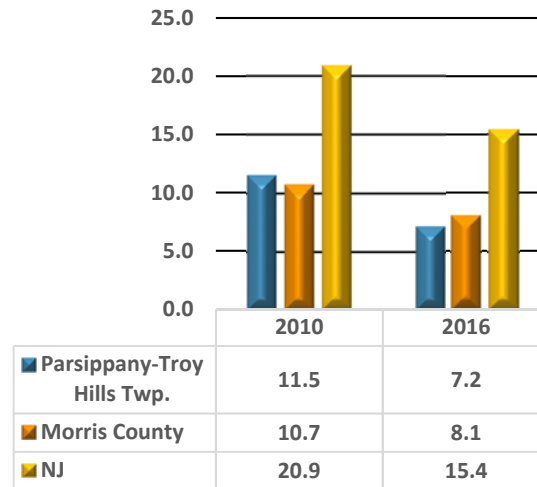
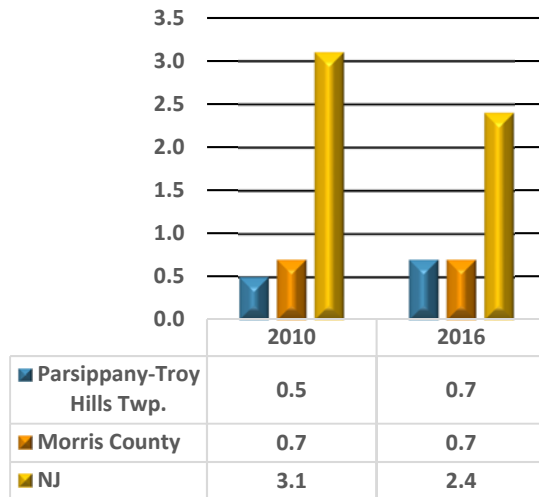
